1. THE TOWNSVILLE MOTORCYCLE CLUB INC, HEREAFTER CALLED THE PROMOTER, WILL CONDUCT A CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES FOR MOTOCROSS AT THE WOODSTOCK TRACK, ON THE ABOVE DATES.
2. JURISDICTION:
  - 2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by MQ who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number (TBA) and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National, Club, Nipper/Mini and One Meeting Licences (OML to junior riders if they hold a current JCP Log Book), who are full financial members of the Townsville Motorcycle Club (no discount or one day memberships are allowed).
  - 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by MQ.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:
  - 3.1. Entries open forthwith and will be accepted on the day of the meetings, before the close of Scrutineering.
  - 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Club, if such retention is approved by MQ.
  - 3.3. Only entries received on the official Entry Form that are accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
4. INSURANCE:
  - 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
  - 4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.
  - 4.3. IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:  
 Ambulance vehicle and two officers on site from the beginning of practice until 15 minutes after racing has finished.

6. ENTRY FEE:
  - 6.1. Junior \$30.00 SENIORS \$35.00 EXTRA CLASS \$5.00 PER CLASS
  - 6.2. Payment by CASH OR CHEQUE only.

ANY FEES FOR DISHONoured CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT.

### 8 AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

Ribbons to third at end of each days racing. 50cc Auto Demo class all receive a participation ribbon. Trophies awarded at Presentation night. Snr Unlimited will be run on the day, but not scored and no overall trophy at end of year.

To be eligible for end of year trophies, riders must have competed in 4 of the 6 designated club days for 2010. The championship awards/perpetual trophies remain the property of the Townsville Motorcycle Club and are to be returned to the club at the end of each year.

### 9 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

9.1 To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be no less than six (6).

9.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to combine events shall be at the discretion of the club officials, subject to MQ approval. Some junior age classes may be combined.

### 10.0 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

10.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Competition.

10.2 Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted.

10.3 Change of machinery may be permitted if submitted to the Clerk of Course and with the approval of the MQ Steward prior to the start of the race. Substitute machine must have passed machine examination, be eligible for the class and replace a machine that cannot be reasonably repaired. Lap scorers must be notified of change prior to race or rider will not be lap scored. All riders to wear back numbers or will not be scored, including seniors and juniors.

### 11.0 RIDING NUMBERS:

11.1. Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their Registered Riding Number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Club's discretion.

11.2. All Number Plates on all Machines MUST comply with the GCR's.

11.3 Back numbers - all competitors (Junior & Senior) must wear legible machine identification number on his/her back. Any rider that does not display an approved back number whilst competing MAY NOT be awarded points for that leg of racing.

### 12.0 GRID POSITIONS:

Positions will be drawn if necessary; otherwise an orderly manner is required to obtain grid position.

### 13.0 RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing and ALL Competitors MUST attend the Riders Briefing. Riders Briefing is a NON Smoking Area. Practice begins after Riders Briefing. Race order to be announced at briefing and also displayed on board in pit area.

### 14.0 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

14.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.

14.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at MQ discretion until the results of the tests are known.

### 15.0 CODE OF CONDUCT:

All Competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all Motorcycle Race Meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

### 16.0 TIMETABLE:

Nominations & Machinery 7.15am, Riders' Briefing 8.30 am Practice 8.45 am with racing to follow.

For the purpose of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to 7.15am with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue. A time will be made available during scrutineering for riders to walk the track.



### 17.0 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

As per current track licence.

### 18.0 STARTS:

All starts will be by self-penalizing gates. A maximum of forty (40) gates will be used for motocross.

### 19.0 RACING:

Minimum 6 laps x 3 races on the designed track for the day. Practice is 5 laps or ten minutes whichever is less. The maximum number of riders for practice is 125% of the number of starting gates. First lap will be under a yellow flag.

### 20.0 NOISE:

As per current GCR's.

## 21.0 SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS

### MACHINE EXAMINATION

THIS WILL BE CONDUCTED NEXT TO THE CANTEEN IN THE DESIGNATED AREA. ALL MACHINES, HELMETS AND PROTECTORS MUST BE PRESENTED. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL MEAN EXCLUSION FROM MEETING.

EACH COMPETITOR IS REQUIRED TO HAVE A REPRESENTATIVE FOR ALL CLUB DAYS. UPON REQUEST, THAT REPRESENTATIVE MUST BE ABLE TO ACT AS FLAG MARSHALL, OFFICIAL OR HELPER. \*\*\*\*\* FAILURE TO SUPPLY A REPRESENTATIVE UPON REQUEST, WILL MEAN EXCLUSION FOR THE RIDER/S.

FLAG ROSTER BOARDS MUST BE FILLED FOR ALL THREE ROUNDS BEFORE RACING COMMENCES FOR THE DAY.

### GUARDIANSHIP FORMS

RIDERS 18 YEARS AND UNDER MUST HAVE A GUARDIANSHIP FORM SIGNED BY THEIR PARENTS OR GUARDIANS IF NOT ACCOMPANIED BY THEM ON THE DAY OF RACING. IF THIS FORM IS NOT FILLED OUT, AND HANDED IN AT SIGN ON, THAT RIDER WILL NOT BE RIDING. NO EXCEPTIONS.
